Role Summary

Reporting to the CEO, this role is responsible for negotiations of key licences, stakeholder management, contract administration, licence development and regulatory affairs. Responsible for licence income budget of approximately \$45million per annum.

Licence Negotiations

- Take a lead role in negotiations of key licences, in conjunction with the CEO, analysing value of licences and developing value propositions
- Understand and communicate licence terms, rights, pricing and/or features of the licence products

Licence Stakeholder Management

- Develop and drive strategic relationships with stakeholders including plans, programs, projects and initiatives
- Develop and maintain strong internal and external relationships to exchange information with licences, and other stakeholders

Licence Development

- Understand the commercial drivers of organisations we license, or could license, to inform ongoing product design and evolution
- Identify potential new licence opportunities and expand reach of licences
- Understand the legal framework of the licences, and their operation within copyright law

Contract Administration

- Prepare, negotiate and review licensing contracts
- Manage invoicing in conjunction with the Finance Department

REGULATORY AFFAIRS

 Understand copyright policy issues as they relate to Screenrights and the audiovisual content industry more widely



- In conjunction with the CEO and Legal Department, develop Screenrights' response to government enquiries into copyright law and related matters
- · Draft submissions on behalf of Screenrights
- With the CEO advocate Screenrights' position to policy makers and industry stakeholders
